White Wines

By the glass and bottle

1. **Pleno Viura - Navarra, Spain**

Aromatic and juicy with subtle tropical fruit aromas. The palate finishes crisp and dry with a mouth watering edge.

2. **Los Vilos Sauvignon Blanc - Central Valley, Chile**

Zingy racy acidity and soft gooseberry flavours combine in this wine that is the perfect partner for our fish and shellfish options. This is more weighty than other Sauvignon from Chile and shows the quality of the producer.

3. **Drakensberg Chenin Blanc - Paarl, South Africa** **£13.50**

Light and fresh aromas displaying sweet grapefruit and tangy lime character lead to a palate which is crisp and shows citrus and green apple fruit flavours. The finish is spritzy and has the refreshing bite of bitter lemon.

4. **Pampas del Sur Alto Viognier - Mendoza, Argentina** **£14.50**

Often seen as an alternative to Chardonnay this is a fantastic value for money wine. Apricot, honey and pineapple overtones abound on the nose and palate. Lovely stuff!

5. **Pure Pinot Grigio - Trentino, Italy** **£14.95**

Refreshing apple and citrus fruit flavours are to the fore, with well balanced acidity and notes of almond on the nose.

6. **Paua Bay Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough, New Zealand** £16.95
Sauvignon at its true Southern hemisphere best, lively and fresh with herbaceous and gooseberry flavours with a tropical fruit finish.
7. **Bacchus Chapeldown - Kent, England** £19.95
Delicious floral bouquet, rich melony flavours with a delightful lemony balance. Seen as one of the best English wines on the market, this curious grape is well worth a try!
8. **Chablis Domaine Testut - Burgundy, France** £21.95
What Chablis is all about- clean mineral style with soft fruity notes. A great producer who is gaining more and more acclaim with each vintage.
9. **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc
Marlborough, New Zealand** £32.95
Pale straw green in colour and vibrantly aromatic this wine is like an exotic infusion of fresh ginger, sweet basil, and lemongrass layered over ripe tropical and citrus fruits. With great purity of fruit flavours, the palate is mouth-wateringly juicy yet finishes with a refreshing crispness.

10. **Merlot Rosé, Finca El Picador - Central Valley, Chile**
Strawberry pink in the glass, a lovely basket of fresh summer fruits and razor sharp acidity- give it a go!

11. **Pinot Grigio Ca'Solare Rosé - Piedmont, Italy**
This is a coppery pink wine with an overtly delicious and refreshing tang on the finish- soft summer fruits mingle with a mouth-watering finish.

12. **Pleno Tempranillo - Navarra, Spain**
Rich and succulent berry fruit pervade the nose and palate. A smooth and ripe mouth-watering finish.

13. **Los Vilos Merlot - Central Valley, Chile**
Medium bodied with lovely flavours of sweet plum fruit and a mellow, soothing finish.

14. **Pampas del Sur Malbec - Mendoza, Argentina** £13.95
Raspberry and currant aromas with a hint of toasty vanilla and a delicious, succulent palate supported by ripe velvety tannins.
15. **Rioja Vega Bodegas Muerza - Rioja, Spain** £15.95
From one of the most forward thinking and award winning wineries in Rioja, comes a silky fruity wine with a little spice. A rare opportunity for value from this region.
16. **L'Aristocrate Shiraz Viognier - South France** £16.95
Shiraz with a small amount of Viognier is the classic blend of Cote Rotie in the northern Rhone. The rich sweetness of the Shiraz is beautifully cut and lifted by the addition of just 5% Viognier. Quite delicious!

Red Wines continued.

17. **Private Selection Shiraz, Craneford Wines - Australia** £17.95
Produced by John Zlim , a top producer from the Barossa Valley this is a rich spicy full flavoured Shiraz that lingers on the palate with chocolate and fruits of the forest overtones.
18. **Fleurie Domaine Pardon - Beaujolais, France** £19.50
Intense fruit, concentrated and complex. Lovely rich dark berry fruits, warm succulent tannins and oozing fresh spicy flavours.
19. **Chianti Classico Villa Caffagio - Tuscany, Italy** £22.95
Hand harvested grapes with a 15 day maceration to extract colour and soft tannins. 12 months ageing in cask gives a big, rich wine of massive concentration with a wonderfully refined black cherry and spicy plum fruitiness.
20. **Chateauneuf-du-Pape Telegramme** £31.95
Le Vieux Telegraphe - Rhone, France
A very open expressive wine from one of the Rhone's most revered producers. Easy cherry fruits and a soft velvety texture are to the fore on this stunning wine.

Sparkling Wine and Champagne

21. **'S' Brut Sandford Estate - Victoria, Australia** £14.95
Early harvesting results in a beautiful, exuberant wine, refreshing with a hint of spice and a long lively finish.
22. **Nyetimber Classic Brut - Sussex, England** £32.95
Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier blend- the grapes of Champagne. This West Sussex vineyard has produced a fine, full-bodied, sparkler to rival any French equivalent.

Sparkling Wine and Champagne continued.

23. **Georges Gardet Brut Special NV** £34.95
Becoming widely known for its quality this is a truly fantastic and value for money Champagne, often described as "mini-Krug"! A delicious, elegant wine offering great complexity and length, being aged for a minimum of 4 years before its release there is an added richness that is something to behold.
24. **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV** £39.95
Dominated by Pinot Noir, this wine has a firm structure. Nearly a third of Chardonnay gives this famous bubbly its elegance and finesse.
25. **Laurent- Perrier Cuvee Rose NV** £59.95
The one and only! Produced to give superb forward fruit flavours and a rounded finish- the best pink fizz around!

Dessert Wine

26. **Avondale Muscat Rouge - Paarl, South Africa** £12.95
Full-bodied velvety mouth feel with a melange of raisins and chocolate berries - a decadent delight.



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
